Our theme

For the summer term, our topic is 'Jumanji'. We will be linking all our learning to the film Jumanji. This includes draw-

ing eyes in our art lessons, creating Jumanji inspired games in DT and map drawing in Geography. The children will have the opportunity to design their own Jumanji board games and immerse themselves within the film.

English

Our writing in English will also be linked to our theme and we will be writing narratives and descriptions based around Jumanji. We will also be writing persuasive leaflets, persuading people to come and visit our own Jumanji theme parks, which we will create! Through all of this writing, we will continue to improve our grammar and sentence structure skills.

In addition, we will continue to work on our reading skills of inference and deduction as well as learning new vocabulary and improving our reading fluency.

Maths

Our Maths lessons this term will have a large focus on revising all the topics we have previously covered. We will ensure that all children are confident in using formal methods to calculate with the four operations and also have a good grasp of mathematical vocabulary. We will continue to look at the key skills required to answer mathematical questions quickly and effectively.

You can continue to support your child by engaging them in every day maths situations including telling the time, handling money and reading measures. In order to prepare children for their SATs, practicing the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will be essential. It is also important your child knows the times tables up to the twelve times table, forwards and backwards, and the associated division facts e.g. $63 \div 9 = 7$. All children have access to Times Table Rock-Stars and should be using this regularly.



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Key Messages

- PE lessons: On the day of your child's P.E lesson, they are to come to school in their kits (tracksuits, a white T shirt and a school sweat shirt. They can bring a different sweat shirt to change into.
- Check your class dojo story to find the P.E days for your child's class
