Therefore, the scheme can be used to teach the phonics seamlessly from Nursery to Key Stage One. The scheme also covers the Year 1 spelling patterns and will soon cover the Year2 required spelling patterns.

Over the last few academic years our school has invested in further reading scheme books for our children. We find the children enjoy reading the texts included in the reading scheme and progress well using these. These books can be used alongside Supersonic Phonic Friends and therefore Supersonic Phonic Friends in an ideal fit in our school.

At White Hall Academy we aim to work closely with the children's parents to support their learning.
