Policy statements – how do we operate?

Behaviour – At White Hall Academy Nursery children are encouraged to be caring, co-operative, safe, respectful and helpful. We encourage positive behaviour as part of learning in a supportive setting. This promotes self-esteem, confidence, safety and self-discipline. Strategies will be discussed and shared with parents for consistency. We also offer parenting courses and family learning/adult education opportunities.

“Risky play” – Whilst our activities are risk assessed, we are committed to the benefits of offering exciting activities indoors and out, and all-weather play.

Safeguarding – We have all been police vetted/checked to meet OFSTED criteria to ensure your child’s welfare and safety, and staff have paediatric first-aid training. We also have a statutory ‘duty of care’ to protect your child, and this means following the SET procedures; where possible we will try to discuss any concerns we have with you first.

Equal Opportunities – Every child is different and has different needs, interests and abilities. At White Hall Academy Nursery we help every child to reach their potential, and treat every family with confidentiality and equal concern. Children are encouraged to play and develop in an anti-discriminatory environment.

Special needs – We promote inclusion; if your child needs additional help, activities or resources to make progress with their learning we will do our best to support him/her.
